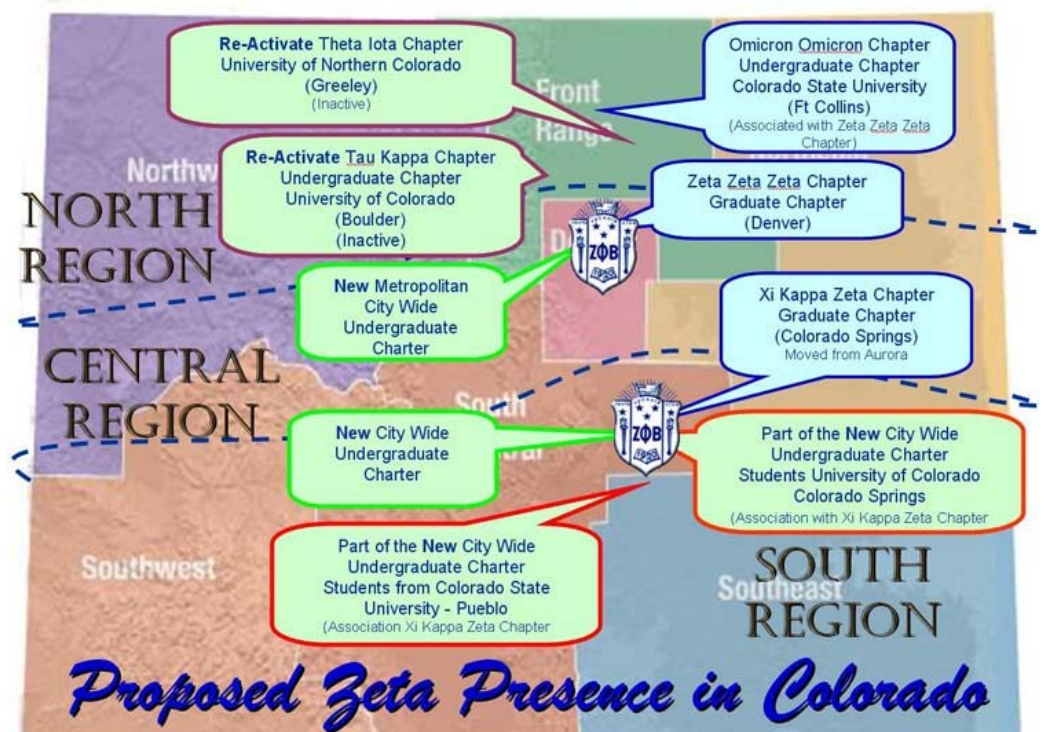


Colorado is a large state and we would like to share the light of Zeta with those who are ready to focus on helping their communities while we focus on helping each other.
